The main aim of the Erasmus+ project called VITA (Virtual & Augmented Reality Trainers Toolbox to Enable Adults Catch Up With Life Skills) is to develop a novel toolbox by which adult trainers can attract, reach out and assist adult learners to catch up with 21st century life skills, particularly digital literacy.

The project is funded under the Erasmus+ Programme through Malta's national agency, EUPA. It runs for 24 months, between October 2017 and October 2018.

Emerging Results

Through IO6 - E-Learning Content on VAR Technology for Adult Trainers of 21st Century Digital Skills - the partners have developed an e-learning course explicitly aimed at adult trainers to help them feel confident in exploiting Virtual and Augmented Reality Technology in their day-to-day work.

This course is being incorporated into the VITA Digital Training Toolbox, enabling trainers to learn from and refer to this content at their own pace and in their own time.

The content is essentially divided into the following modules:

An Introduction to the VITA Course

An Introduction to Digital User Interface

Basic Communication in Digital Environments

Creating, Handling and Storing Basic Digital Content

An Introduction to Virtual and Augmented Reality

Project Meeting #3

A project meeting took place in Athens, Greece on 12 November 2018 during which project partners consolidated the Toolbox content which was initially developed in English, and defined deadlines for the content to be translated to Romanian, Czech and Greek. The conceptual design of the Trainers Toolbox was also presented and a framework for its dissemination and exploitation was discussed.

On 28 February 2019, Drosostalida organised an event in Piraeus, Greece, supported by Vocational Training Centre IRIS. The event highlighted the skills gap in digital competences and the importance of training courses such as VITA's. Participants also had the opportunity to learn more about hands on case studies and other training material for AR development.
